School Safety Specialist Deadline

Reminder: On **Wednesday, January 17, 2018**, all New Jersey school districts must designate a school administrator as a school safety specialist. All superintendents should take action before that date to designate their district's school safety specialist.

This new law requires that the Department of Education provide a training certification program free of charge to your district's school safety specialist on bullying, hazing, truancy, internet safety, emergency planning, emergency drills, drugs, weapons, gangs and school policing.

New Carbon Monoxide Regulation

On June 5, 2017, the State Department of Community Affairs adopted regulations requiring the installation of carbon monoxide detectors in all buildings (including schools) where there is a fuel-burning appliance or an attached garage. Compliance was required by September 3, 2017.
