Special Ed - Acting Out continues to be the number one reported claim each month. One of the preventative measures that NJSIG offers to our membership is our Non-Violent Crisis Intervention Training available through our Safety and Risk Control Department. For only \$25 per attendee, just the cost of the materials and certification, this training demonstrates to staff how to deescalate a potential crisis situation. This is available to all district employees who may encounter children who act out that could potentially present danger to themselves as well as others.
