

**CERTIFICATION OF NON-INVOLVEMENT IN PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES  
IN RUSSIA OR BELARUS**

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-49.5 and N.J.S.A. 52:32-60.1 et seq. (P.L. 2022, c. 3), any person or entity (hereinafter “Vendor”) that submits a bid or proposal or otherwise proposes to enter into or renew a contract with a board of education as defined in and subject to the provisions of the “Public School Contracts Law” (P.L. 1977, c. 114) must complete the certification below indicating whether or not the Vendor is identified on the Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons list, available here: <https://sanctionsearch.ofac.treas.gov>. If the Department of the Treasury finds that a Vendor has made a certification in violation of the law, it shall take any action as may be appropriate and provided by law, rule, or contract, including but not limited to imposing sanctions, seeking compliance, recovering damages, declaring the party in default, and seeking debarment or suspension of the party.

I, the undersigned, certify that I have read the definition of “Vendor” below, and have reviewed the Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons list, and having done so certify (check the appropriate box):

A. That the Vendor is not identified on the OFAC Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons list on account of activity related to Russia and/or Belarus.

**OR**

B. That I am unable to certify as to “A” above, because the Vendor is identified on the OFAC Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons list on account of activity related to Russia and/or Belarus.

**OR**

C. That I am unable to certify as to “A” above, because the Vendor is identified on the OFAC Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons list. However, the Vendor is engaged in activity related to Russia and/or Belarus consistent with federal law, regulation, license, or exemption. A detailed description of how the Vendor’s activity related to Russia and/or Belarus is consistent with federal law is set forth below.

<sup>1</sup> “Vendor” means: (1) a natural person, corporation, company, limited partnership, limited liability partnership, limited liability company, business association, sole proprietorship, joint venture, partnership, society, trust, or any other nongovernmental entity, organization, or group; (2) any governmental entity or instrumentality of a government, including a multilateral development institution, as defined in Section 1701(c)(3) of the International Financial Institutions Act, 22 U.S.C. 262r(c)(3); or (3) any parent, successor, subunit, direct or indirect subsidiary, or any entity under common ownership or control with, any entity described in (1) or (2). See N.J.S.A. 52:32-60.1(e).
