

Preparing for Hurricane Season

Reports have been issued by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) that predict this year's hurricane season will be above normal. The hurricane season runs from June 1 to November 30. The NOAA believes there is a 45% chance of above-normal activity for hurricane season, a 35% chance of a near-normal season and a 20% chance of a below-normal activity. It is being forecasted that the Atlantic hurricane region could expect 5-9 hurricanes, including 2-4 that could be severe. This compares to the average season, which produces six hurricanes, including three major hurricanes.


