

NJSIG's Quarterly Loss Runs and Broker Dashboard Updates

NJSIG is continuing our efforts to go paperless. Beginning in January, 2021, paper loss runs will no longer be sent out via mail at the end of quarter. Moving forward, quarterly loss runs requests will be managed by brokers through the NJSIG Broker Dashboard. In order for members to receive their quarterly loss runs, NJSIG's broker partners must "opt in" on behalf of each district and provide an email address for distribution.

This feature will not take the place of any special request loss runs or any loss runs that members or brokers currently have scheduled. This is specifically for the **quarterly** loss runs that we have been sending by mail to members.

To access this "opt in," brokers will need to login to their <u>NJSIG Broker Dashboard</u>. There is a new link on the left-hand side that will allow the brokers to manage individual district quarterly loss runs.
