Active Assailant Preparedness: Administrators (Dorn & Nguyen, 46 mins) -This course prepares personnel for active shooter situations by covering how they occur, prevention strategies, preparedness, and response actions.

Active Assailant Preparedness Part 2: Staff (Dorn & Nguyen, 62 mins) - Similar to the previous course but tailored for staff, it provides information on active shooter incidents, including prevention strategies, preparedness, and response actions.

Crisis Response and Recovery (Dorn & Shepherd, 22 mins) - This awareness-level course covers the fundamentals of crisis management, including effective response plans, stress reactions, and recovery strategies.
