## According to the National Safety Council (NSC), the three main types of distractions are:

- Visual distractions anything that takes your eyes off the road
- Manual distractions anything that takes your hands off the wheel
- Cognitive distractions anything that takes your mind off of driving

# Online Defensive Driving Training

NJSIG has also partnered with National Safety Council (NSC) to offer the Online Defensive Driving Course to NJSIG members who drive on behalf of the district.

This **online course** is approved by the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission and is 4 hours in length. Each driver must pass a mandatory test at the end of the course with a score of 80% or better to receive a Defensive Driving Certificate. Also, drivers may qualify for a mandatory insurance rate reduction of up to 10% for 3 years (driver should contact their insurance agent for details). You may be allowed to receive up to a two-point reduction from the accumulated points you currently have on your driving record. You may only receive a twopoint reduction once every 5 years and only if there are points on your driving record at the time you complete the course.
