New Jersey is warming faster than the national average, with extreme heat events becoming more frequent and lasting longer. The [New Jersey Department of Health](#) provides guidance to help schools prepare for hot and humid weather.

School Building Reminders

- Check on all buildings regularly
- Secure vacant and partially used buildings
- Check HVAC systems in occupied areas
- Watch for overheating or poor ventilation
- Restrict access to closed facilities

Hot Weather Safety

- Stay cool and hydrated
- Limit outdoor activity during peak heat
- Watch for heat-related illness
- Monitor weather and air quality
