Question 1: Do we need to be Bonded?

NJSIG is looking to bring our current PeopleSoft environment up to the most current image, while determining if NJSIG's custom billing interface is a better solution than the delivered (out of the box) features PeopleSoft offers in the most recent image 40 release. A PUM Image Upgrade Assessment or evaluation of NJSIG's current PeopleSoft environment would be required before a plan is created to upgrade.
