Parents & Community as Partners: A Pathway for Reducing Legal Exposure

With parents and community members as partners, it becomes possible to make real progress on seemingly intractable issues such as budget referendums, chronic absenteeism, improper student behavior, and early identification and response for issues that could develop into crisis situations. This session will explore a range of real-world scenarios where breakdowns in communication between parents and school officials often lead to mistrust, conflict and litigation between school districts and parents, and reviews how to apply a common sense framework to reduce potential legal exposure and find a constructive path forward, using LEGAL ONE's LIGHT system.
